How a Bill Becomes a Law

(STARTE

A person like you has an idea for a new **law**, so they write a letter to a Senator or Representative.

The Senator or Representative likes the person's idea, so they introduce a **bill**.

The **bill** is talked about and reviewed by the Senate and the House of Representatives.

The House of Representatives and the Senate vote on the **bill**.

The **bill** goes to the President.

VETO-

If the President **vetoes** the **bill**, it goes back to the House and Senate

If two-thirds of both the houses vote to approve the bill, they override the President's veto and it becomes a law.

OR

SIGN-

If the President likes the bill, and signs it, it becomes a law.
