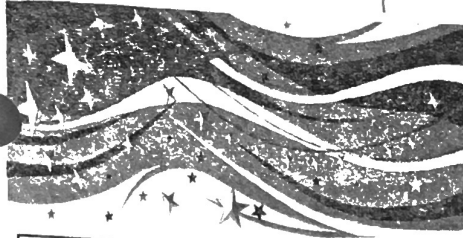

How a Bill Becomes a Law

START

A person like you has an idea for a new **law**, so they write a letter to a Senator or Representative.

The Senator or Representative likes the person's idea, so they introduce a **bill**.

The **bill** is talked about and reviewed by the Senate and the House of Representatives.

The House of Representatives and the Senate vote on the **bill**.

The **bill** goes to the President.

VETO

If the President **veto**es the **bill**, it goes back to the House and Senate.

If two-thirds of both the houses vote to approve the **bill**, they **override** the President's veto and it becomes a **law**.

OR

SIGN

If the President likes the **bill**, and signs it, it becomes a **law**.
